TRAFFIC PURSUIT

Whitewater Township, September 27, 2015 – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports a traffic pursuit that began at the Whitewater split of IR 275 and IR 74, in Whitewater Twp. . At approximately 10:09 p.m., Sheriff's units attempted to make a traffic stop on a black Sion TC driven by Wyatt William Buhl, Male, White, 18yrs old. Deputy Anthony Crider observed Mr. Buhl's vehicle stopped at IR 275 northbound on the ramp to IR 74 eastbound. As Deputy Crider was pulling over, Mr. Buhl jumped out of his vehicle and started waving his hands in the air. When Deputy Crider exited his cruiser Mr. Buhl got back in his vehicle and drove off traveling eastbound on IR 74. Mr. Buhl continued to travel eastbound on IR 74 to eastbound IR275, traveling in excess 100 MPH. In an attempt to stop Mr. Buhl officers from Springfield Township, Sharonville and the Hamilton County Sheriff's Office deployed several sets of stop sticks. After striking the fourth set of stop sticks, Mr.Buhl's vehicle came to a stop eastbound on IR275 at Cornell. Mr. Buhl exited his vehicle and fled on foot jumping over the cement barrier running across the westbound lanes of travel. Mr. Buhl was taken into custody in the wood line along IR275 without further incident. Mr. Buhl was charged Failure to Comply, Possession of Marijuana, Resisting Arrest and OVI.
