## WOMAN STRUCK BY VEHICLE IN ANDERSON TOWNSHIP.

**Anderson Township, October, 26<sup>th</sup> 2015** – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports a driverless vehicle struck and killed a woman at 1696 Rudyard Lane in Anderson Township on Monday, October 26, 2015 at 5:41 pm.

A 2003 Jeep Cherokee was parked in the garage at 1696 Rudyard Lane. Erica Massa, female, age 36, a resident at 1696 Rudyard Lane was standing in the garage. The Jeep began to roll backwards causing it to strike Erica Massa. As the vehicle continued to roll backwards Mrs. Massa was pinned between the vehicle door and the garage pillar. Anderson Township Fire Department responded and transported to University Hospital where she was pronounced deceased.

Alcohol and drugs were not factors in this incident.

The incident remains under investigation by the Hamilton County Sheriff's Office Traffic Safety Unit.
