ARRESTS MADE IN COUNTERFEIT NFL TICKETS

Whitewater Township, November 4, 2015 – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports the arrest of two individuals by Agents assigned to the Regional Narcotics Highway Interdiction Unit today on interstate 74 in Whitewater Township.

The two subjects were stopped on a traffic violation and after a narcotics canine alerted on the vehicle officers located drug paraphernalia as well as 60 counterfeit NFL professional football tickets and 20 parking passes. The tickets and parking passes were both for this Thursday's nationally televised Cincinnati Bengals vs. Cleveland Browns game at Paul Brown Stadium, and this Sunday's game at Lucas Oil Stadium between the Indianapolis Colts and the Denver Broncos. Officers arrested Glenn Poindexter, age 45 of the Bronx, New York and Bruce Soares, age 45 from Engelwood, New Jersey. Both individuals were charged with criminal simulation, a 4th degree felony and forgery, a 3rd degree felony.

Both individuals will be transported to the Hamilton County Justice Center to await their arraignment. The counterfeit tickets hold a face value (if they were legitimate) of \$8045, however for sold out games like we have this Thursday these criminals likely would have scammed buyers out of much more. The parking passes did not have a dollar amount.

This matter remains under investigation by the Hamilton County Sheriff's Office.
