BARRICADED SUBJECT IN SYCAMORE TOWNSHIP

Hamilton County Ohio, November 14, 2015, 2015 – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports a barricaded subject in the 7900 block of Irwin Avenue in Sycamore Township on November 14, 2015.

At Approximately 3:00 P.M., Hamilton County Dispatch was contacted about a male white, age 63, threatening suicide and making threats to harm responding officers if they responded. Sheriff's Units responded and surrounded the residence and attempted to make contact with the male suspect. All attempts to contact the suspect failed and the Hamilton County Special Response Team responded to the scene. After all negotiation attempts failed with the male suspect, The Hamilton County Special Response Team made entry and took the suspect into custody without further incident.

The male suspect, David Camarata, was charged with Inducing Panic and taken to University Hospital for medical evaluation.

This case remains under investigation by the Hamilton County Sheriffs Office.
