## SUSPECT WANTED – 90 YR OLD VICTIM

**Miami Township, November 2, 2015** – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports this morning at approximately 8:30 A.M. a 90 year old male was the victim of an aggravated robbery and kidnapping at his residence (5076 Zion Road).

A suspect described as a male, white in his 20's wearing dark pants and dark hoodie, a goatee, approx. 5'10" – 6" and 175 lbs. gained access to the home, brandished a knife and demanded money and other valuables. After the victim provided cash the suspect tied the victim up and stole his vehicle.

The suspect left the residence in the stolen vehicle described as a four door gray / silver 1998 Buick Lesabre with Ohio License Plate # CEV7284.

At this time, other than being traumatized it does not appear the victim was physically injured.
