HOMICIDE INVESTIGATION IN LINCOLN HEIGHTS

Village of Lincoln Heights, December 11, 2015 – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports the Murder of Raj-Paul Doughty, a male black 26 years of age. Mr. Doughty lived in the Village of Lockland, Hamilton County, Ohio.

On December 11, 2015, at approximately 12:15 a.m., Mr. Doughty was inside Lamarr's Lounge located at 9568 Wayne Avenue in the Village of Lincoln Heights. Mr. Doughty and another male black (identity unknown) had a dispute inside the bar. During the dispute, Mr. Doughty was shot several times. Woodlawn paramedics transported Mr. Doughty to University Hospital where he was pronounced deceased.
