## CRUISER CRASH IN CROSBY TOWNSHIP

**Crosby Township, December 13, 2015** – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports a two vehicle crash involving a Colerain Township cruiser that occurred on New Haven Road in the 8300 block in Crosby Township on Sunday December 13, 2015 at approximately 5:45 p.m.

A 2015 Ford Fusion being operated by Richard Douglas Taylor, male, age 52, Fairfield OH, was eastbound on New Haven Road. A marked Colerain Township cruiser being operated by a Colerain Township officer was traveling westbound on New Haven Road. Mr. Taylor crossed the center line into oncoming traffic and struck the Colerain Township cruiser head on. Both vehicles were disabled as a result of the collision.

The Colerain Township officer was transported from the scene by a Colerain Township officer to a local hospital with non-life threatening injuries.

Mr. Taylor was transported to U.C. Hospital via Air Care and was being treated for non-life threatening injuries. Mr. Taylor was not utilizing his safety restraints at the time of the crash.

Prescription drugs are believed to be a factor in this crash.

The crash remains under investigation by the Hamilton County Sheriff's Traffic Safety Unit with the assistance of the Colerain Township Traffic Safety Unit.
