VEHICLE PURSUIT IN GREEN TOWNSHIP

Green Township, January 23, 2016 – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil and Chief Bart West, Green Township Police Department, report a vehicle pursuit that occurred at 7:59 P.M. in the area of Colerain Avenue just south of Byrneside Drive. A Hamilton County Sheriff's Deputy observed a 2007 Honda Accord in which a computer check revealed that it had a stolen license plate. A traffic stop was attempted in the area of Colerain and Byrneside, at which time the suspect vehicle continued northbound ignoring the deputy's lawful order to stop. The suspect vehicle turned eastbound on Banning and upon approaching Acre, the suspect vehicle slowed and a male black passenger fled from the vehicle on foot. The suspect vehicle continued on Banning, turned right on Kipling, onto Willowcove, and onto Intern. The suspect vehicle came to a stop after striking a parked vehicle in the driveway of the 2200 block of Intern Ct. A male black suspect fled on foot from the vehicle in a northbound direction. A canine track subsequently ensued, however produced negative results.

The driver is described as a male, black in his late teens to early twenties. The suspect was wearing dark colored pants and a black hoodie. The second suspect, the passenger in the vehicle, is described as a male, black also in his late teens to early twenties. He was wearing blue jeans, a grey hoodie and a white t-shirt.

The incident remains under investigation by the Hamilton County Sheriff / Green Township Police Investigative Unit.
