## "SINGLE POT" METH LAB DISCOVERED DURING TRAFFIC STOP

**Anderson Township, February 7, 2016** – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports a traffic stop in the 1100 block of Asbury Rd at 10:16 P.M. A traffic stop was conducted on a vehicle for an equipment violation. The deputy conducting the stop observed an object being thrown from the vehicle as it was coming to a stop. Upon further investigation, a plastic bottle had been thrown from the vehicle containing materials used for a "single pot" meth lab. The scene was secured and agents from The Regional Narcotics Unit responded to the scene to safely take into possession the potentially volatile substance.

Charles Ross, age 26, and Ryan Dawson, age 30, were both charged with the Illegal Assembly or Possession of Chemicals for the Manufacture of Drugs, a violation of O.R.C. 2925.041, and both were subsequently transported to the Hamilton County Justice Center.
