SERIOUS SINGLE VEHICLE CRASH IN CROSBY TOWNSHIP

Crosby Township, February, 21st 2016 – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports a single vehicle crash that occurred at the intersection of New Haven Rd and Mt Hope Rd in Crosby Township on Sunday February 21, 2016 at 9:52 pm.

A 2008 Scion Xb operated by a 16 year old female of Harrison, Ohio was traveling eastbound on New Haven Rd approaching the bend at Mt Hope Rd. The operator lost control of her vehicle and ran off the roadway. The vehicle struck a guardrail and a utility post.

The driver was transported to Childrens Hospital by Harrison Township Fire Department for treatment of non-life threatening injuries.

A 15 year old female passenger was transported to Childrens Hospital by Crosby Township Fire Department for treatment of non-life threatening injuries.

The driver was utilizing her safety restraints and the passenger was not utilizing her safety restraints at the time of this crash.

Alcohol, drugs and speed are not believed to be factors in the crash. The crash remains under investigation by the Hamilton County Sheriff's Traffic Safety Unit.

Per Duke Energy, the intersection of New Haven Rd, Dry Fork Rd, and Mt Hope Rd will be closed for an undetermined amount of time. This may be a factor for Monday morning rush hours.
