HAMILTON COUNTY SHERIFF'S FUGITIVE UNIT ARRESTS SUSPECT IN 2008 COLD CASE MURDER

Hamilton County, Ohio, March 31, 2016 – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports the Hamilton County Sheriff's Office Fugitive Unit arrested Kyrie Maxberry on an outstanding warrant for his connection to a 2008 cold case murder.

On March 24, 2016, Maxberry was indicted on Felonious Assault with gun specifications charges for his role in connection with the murder of Lester Parker Jr. in Lincoln Heights in November of 2008. Maxberry was wanted by the Hamilton County Sheriff's Office and arrested by our Fugitive Unit without incident.

Kyrie Maxberry is currently incarcerated in the Hamilton County Justice Center awaiting arraignment. Patrick Hill, also connected with the same incident in 2008 remains incarcerated as well.
