AIR CARE CALLED TO CRASH IN HARRISON TOWNSHIP

Harrison Township, March 2, 2016 – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports a motor vehicle crash which occurred in the 10900 block of Campbell Road, in Harrison Township, on March 2, 2016 at 6:22 a.m.

A 2000 Dodge Durango operated by Terri Bates, female, age 36, of Cleves, OH was traveling westbound in the 10900 block of Campbell Road. As she traveled through a right curve, Ms. Bates allowed her vehicle to travel left of center into the eastbound lane. After crossing into the eastbound lane, Ms. Bates' vehicle struck a 2014 Ford Focus in a head-on manner. The Ford Focus was being operated by by Frances Quick, female, age 69, of Harrison, OH.

Mrs. Quick was transported to University Hospital, via Air Care. Ms. Bates was transported to Mercy West Hospital by the Bright Fire Department. Both are being treated for non life-threatening injuries.

Both Mrs. Quick and Ms. Bates were wearing seatbelts at the time of the crash. Speed was not a factor in the crash. Drugs are believed to be a factor in the crash.

The crash remains under investigation by the Sheriff's Traffic Safety Unit.
