## SUBJECT IDENTIFIED FROM GLENDALE OFFICER INVOLVED SHOOTING

**Village of Evendale, March 29, 2016** – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports the identification of the man that was a part of the Glendale Police Officer involved shooting at approximately 1:30 pm on March 29, 2016 on Interstate 75 south.

Detectives have identified the individual as Javier Pablo Aleman.

Mr. Aleman was born December 12, 1969 and is 46 years of age. Mr. Aleman was last known to reside in Baltimore County, Maryland. Mr. Aleman is not known to have any connection to the Cincinnati area.

At the time of this incident, Mr. Aleman was a fugitive, wanted by the Baltimore County Maryland Police for a 2016 homicide.

Mr. Aleman is currently in stable condition at University Hospital and will be held on this warrant pending extradition hearings.

The Glendale Officer who fired his weapon at Mr. Aleman has been identified as Patrol Officer Joshua Hilling badge # 7, 31 years of age. Officer Hilling was not injured as a result of this incident.

The investigation into this officer involved shooting is ongoing. The Hamilton County Sheriff's Office will continue to work cooperatively with Chief Warman of the Glendale Police Department and Chief Korte from the Evendale Police Department to bring this investigation to a close.
