THREE VEHICLE FATAL CRASH IN GREEN TWP.

GREEN TOWNSHIP, APRIL 25, 2016 – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil and Chief Bart West, Green Township Police Department, report a three vehicle fatal auto crash that occurred at approximately 1120 Hrs at the intersection of SR-264 (Glenway Avenue) and Bridgetown Road. A 2009 GMC Sierra 1500 pickup truck was being operated by Ronald J. Chaille, age 71, of Cincinnati, Ohio, eastbound in the right through lane on Bridgetown Road, approaching a red light located at the intersection of SR-264 (Glenway Avenue). At the intersection, Mr. Chaille failed to stop at the red light. This action caused a collision with a 2007 Pontiac Vibe, operated by Laura A. Bolt, age 50, of Cincinnati, Ohio, which was traveling southbound through the intersection on SR-264 (Glenway Avenue), in the right through lane. At this point the front portion of Mrs. Bolt's vehicle struck the left rear portion of Mr. Chaille's vehicle. During the collision, Mr. Chaille's vehicle was displaced in a counter clockwise manner, as it traveled into the northbound lanes of travel. At this point the front portion of Mr. Chaille's vehicle struck the left side portion of a 2015 Toyota Camry, operated by Mrs. Teresa L. Scholl, age 51, of Cincinnati, Ohio. Mrs. Scholl was traveling northbound on SR-264 (Glenway Avenue) in the left turn lane, preparing to make a left turn onto westbound Bridgetown Road. During the collision, both Mr. Chaille and Mrs. Scholl's vehicle were redirected off the southeast corner of the intersection. Mr. Chaille's vehicle came to an uncontrolled final rest against a utility pole, facing generally a southwesterly direction and Mrs. Scholl's vehicle came to an uncontrolled final rest facing generally west in the grass. Mrs. Bolt's vehicle came to an uncontrolled final rest, facing generally east across both southbound lanes of SR-264 (Glenway Avenue).

.Mrs. Scholl sustained fatal injuries as a result of the collision and was pronounced dead at the scene by Dr. Dorothy Dean.

The Driver, Mr. Chaille was transported to University Hospital by Green Township E.M.S. for treatment of non-life threatening injuries, sustained during the collision.

Mrs. Bolt refused medical treatment at the scene.

Safety restraints were utilized by all subjects at the time of the crash. Alcohol and or drugs are

not believed to be a factor in the crash.

The crash still remains under investigation by The Hamilton County Sheriff's Traffic Safety Unit.
