Citizens are encouraged to drop off unwanted or expired medication at the locations listed below on Saturday, April 30th. Each site will be open to the public from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. The Federal Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) along with the Hamilton County Sheriff's Office are sponsoring these one-day events providing communities with the ability to safely dispose of medicines in secure locations. It is our goal to reduce the increasing rates of accidental poisonings and prescription drug abuse while protecting the environment.
