TRAFFIC PURSUIT

Columbia Township, Ohio, April 18, 2016 – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports a traffic pursuit that started on Kenwood Road just north of Madison Avenue.

At 12:10 A.M. a Sheriff's Deputy working Columbia Township attempted to initiate a traffic stop on a white four door Chevy Impala for a misdemeanor warrant that came back to the registered owner of the vehicle. The vehicle fled north on Kenwood Road for 5.9 miles and then came to a stop in Blue Ash on Kenwood Road at Zigzag Road due to it mechanical issues. The driver of the vehicle fled on foot and the passenger of the vehicle remained in the vehicle. The passenger was found to have a misdemeanor drug possession warrant and was taken into custody. A Sheriff's K-9 responded and conducted a track in an attempt to locate the driver but the driver of the vehicle was not located.
