AGGRAVATED ROBBERY OF DOMINOS IN ANDERSON TOWNSHIP

Anderson Township, May 17, 2016 – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports an aggravated robbery at the Dominos store located at 1969 Eight Mile Road, Anderson Township.

At 11:06 p.m., May 17, 2016, officers were dispatched to the Dominos store located at 1969 Eight Mile Road for an aggravated robbery that had just occurred. One male black with a black and white bandanna over his face armed with a sawed off shotgun entered the store through the back door and demanded money. The suspect then exited through the rear door and fled on foot westbound on Clough Pike with an undetermined amount of U.S. Currency. There were no injuries as a result of this incident.

The Hamilton County Sheriff's Canine Unit tracked the suspect and was met with negative results.

The suspect is described as male black, black hooded sweat shirt, black pants, black gloves, black shoes armed with a sawed off shotgun wrapped in a black cloth.
