ANDERSON TOWNSHIP - BARRICADED SUBJECT

Anderson Township, May 30, 2016 – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports at 10:00 PM, Hamilton County Sheriff's Units responded to the 1000 block of Pamela Drive for an armed suicidal subject. Upon arrival, the male subject locked himself in the house and was reportedly armed with a gun. Subject threatened to cause harm to himself and refused contact with Sheriff's Deputies at the scene. After numerous unsuccessful attempts were made to contact the subject, the Sheriff's Special Response Team was called to the scene. The subject threatened to cause serious physical harm to the officers and fired multiple shots at them. At 0237, the subject finally surrendered to officers.

No one was injured as a result of this incident. The subject, William Holtman, male white 35 years of age was taken into custody and charged with Inducing Panic, Felonious Assault X 2 and Aggravated Menacing.
