MULTI-VEHICLE CRASH ON NORTHBOUND I-75 AT THE 11.4 MILE MARKER

Arlington Heights, May 19, 2016 – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports a multi-vehicle auto crash, with injuries, that occurred in the area of the 11.4 mile marker on northbound I-75 at 11:05 P.M.

A 2015 Honda Pilot, being operated by Jonathan Wilson of Cincinnati, Ohio, failed to maintain control of his vehicle and struck a guardrail in the area of northbound I-75 at the 11.4 mile marker. As a result of the collision, the Honda Pilot careened off the guardrail and struck a 2008 Dodge, operated by Dianna Nelson-Grevious. The Honda Pilot then struck the high speed guardrail redirecting the Honda in a southbound direction. While traveling southbound, the Honda then struck a semi-tractor trailer, operated by Christopher Hammack. The Honda continued southbound and struck a 2002 Jeep, operated by Leroy Carter. The Honda then continued on to final rest at the ramp from Galbraith Road to northbound I-75. A secondary crash also occurred on northbound I-75 involving two vehicles attempting to avoid the Honda Pilot.

Mr. Carter was transported by squad to Bethesda North Hospital for non-life threatening injuries and has subsequently been released. Mr. Wilson was transported to U.C. Hospital and was listed to be in stable condition.

This crash resulted in the closure of northbound I-75 at Galbraith Road for approximately one hour. Neither drugs nor alcohol are factors in this crash.
