AGGRAVATED ROBBERY

Anderson Township, May 22, 2016 – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports an aggravated robbery which occurred at the Speedway store located in the 5000 block of Batavia Road in Anderson Township.

At approximately 9:30 PM, a suspect armed with a handgun confronted the store employee at the front door of the business and demanded money. The employee complied and placed the money from the cash drawer in the suspect's bag. The suspect was last seen fleeing eastbound from the store on foot. Taken was an undetermined amount of US currency. No injury was reported as a result of the offense.

A canine responded to the scene to assist with the search but the suspect was not located.

The suspect is described as male, white, between 5'8" and 5'10" with a stocky build. The suspect was wearing a black jacket, blue jeans, a black beanie hat with a winter scarf over his face. The suspect was armed with a black semi-automatic handgun.
