AGGRAVATED ROBBERY

UPDATE

Anderson Township, May 23, 2016 – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports a warrant being issued related to the aggravated robbery which occurred at the Speedway store located in the 5000 block of Batavia Road in Anderson Township on May 22, 2016 at 9:30 pm.

Hamilton County Sheriff's investigators working in cooperation with investigators from the Adams County Sheriff's Office announce the arrest of John Fronk II, 36, of West Union, Ohio. Information was developed during an investigation by the Adams County Sheriff's Office and a joint investigation with Hamilton County detectives lead to probable cause for the issuance of a warrant for Mr. Fronk on a single charge of Aggravated Robbery in Hamilton County. Mr. Fronk is in custody in Adams County facing additional charges.

Anderson Township, May 22, 2016- Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports an aggravated robbery which occurred at the Speedway store located in the 5000 block of Batavia Road in Anderson Township.

At approximately 9:30 PM, a suspect armed with a handgun confronted the store employee at the front door of the business and demanded money. The employee complied and placed the money from the cash drawer in the suspect's bag. The suspect was last seen fleeing eastbound from the store on foot. Taken was an undetermined amount of US currency. No injury was reported as a result of the offense.

A canine responded to the scene to assist with the search but the suspect was not located.
