## Lincoln Heights Shootout

**Village of Lincoln Heights, September 19, 2016** – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports updated information related to the numerous shots fired in the Village of Lincoln Heights on September 18, 2016.

There were four victims treated at area hospitals:

- Christopher Kinsey age 26 of Lincoln Heights
- Andre Gilbert age 28 of Lincoln Heights
- Joseph Ford age 50 of Lincoln Heights
- a 17 year old juvenile (whose name is not being released)

All four of these individuals are being treated, or have been treated and released from local hospitals. None of the injuries sustained are believed to be life threatening at this time.

There has been two arrests made so far related to this case.

Christopher Kinsey, who was also injured by gunfire in this incident, was charged with one count of Weapons under Disability (possession of a firearm after prior felony convictions) and receiving stolen property (stolen AR-15 rifle).

Abdullah Luqman, male age 48, of Lincoln Heights was also found to be in possession of two stolen firearms (handguns) as a result of this investigation and was charged with two counts of Receiving Stolen Property.

This was a very violent confrontation with approximately 100 rounds fired. The Hamilton County Sheriff's Office is asking anyone with information about this shooting to please contact our Criminal Investigative Section at (513) 851-6000 or Crime Stoppers at (513) 352-3040.
