## LATEST TELEPHONE SCAM

**Hamilton County, Ohio, November 4, 2016** – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil shared our Sheriff's Office has received multiple new reports of telephone scam attempts on Hamilton County residents.

The caller contacting individuals via telephone identifies himself as Deputy Sizemore from the Hamilton County Sheriff's Office Warrants and Citations Division (which does not exist). The caller informs the potential victim there are warrants out for their arrest and to avoid being arrested he instructs them to send money to a particular location. The phone number the alleged "Deputy Sizemore" is using is (513) 452-5343.

Anyone who receives calls from "Deputy Sizemore" should inform the caller the Sheriff's Office does not and will not ask for money to be paid via a telephone call.
