PEDESTRIAN STRUCK IN ANDERSON TOWNSHIP

Anderson Township, October 31, 2016 – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports a traffic crash which resulted in a pedestrian being struck on Eight Mile Road near Heather Hill Boulevard, in Anderson Township, on October 31, 2016 at 8:10 p.m.

A 2009 Cadillac sedan operated by Cheryl Pastura, age 64, of Cincinnati, OH was traveling northbound on Eight Mile Road just north of Heather Hill Boulevard. A juvenile, age 13, attempted to run east across Eight Mile Road. The juvenile was struck by Mrs. Pastura's vehicle. The juvenile was not in a crosswalk.

The juvenile sustained serious injuries and he was transported to Childrens Hospital by the Anderson Township Fire Department.

Speed and alcohol were not factors in the crash.

The crash remains under investigation by the Hamilton County Sheriff's Traffic Safety Unit.
