PEDESTRIAN STRUCK IN MADEIRA

City of Madeira, January 7, 2017 – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil and City of Madeira Police Chief Dave Schaefer report a traffic crash which resulted in a pedestrian being struck near 7466 Shawnee Run Road, in the City of Madeira, on January 7, 2017 at 10:32 p.m.

A 1998 Honda Civic operated by Jonas Gray, age 24, of Cincinnati, OH was traveling westbound in the 7400 block of Shawnee Run Road. A female, Li Jing Ju, age 39, was standing in the roadway when she was struck by the Honda Civic. According to witnesses and Mr Gray, Ms Ju was not trying to walk across the roadway at the time of the crash. No crosswalks were present at the scene of the crash. A sidewalk is available along the north side of Shawnee Run Road.

Ms Ju sustained serious injuries and was transported to the University of Cincinnati Medical Center by the Madeira & Indian Hill Joint Fire District.

Speed and alcohol were not factors in the crash.

The crash remains under investigation by the Hamilton County Sheriff's Traffic Safety Unit.
