Silverton Assault

Village of Silverton, December 30, 2016 – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports at approximately 8:26 pm, Sheriff's Deputies were dispatched to investigate an assault at 6914 Montgomery Road in Silverton, a ten unit apartment building.

Upon arrival, two male subjects were located with injuries and transported to local hospitals via life squad.

Subject number one is identified as Darwin Weaver, male age 66, who resides at 6914 Montgomery Road.

Subject number two is identified as Rick Johnson, male age 52, who also resides at 6914 Montgomery Road.

Mr. Weaver was pronounced deceased at The Jewish Hospital-Kenwood. Mr. Johnson is listed in stable condition at the University of Cincinnati Medical Center.

Mr. Weaver and Mr. Johnson are known to one another, there is nothing that leads investigators to believe that anyone else in the area is at risk. Furthermore, there is no information at this time that indicates anyone else besides Mr. Weaver and Mr. Johnson were involved in this incident.
