SUSPECT IDENTIFIED IN SHOOTING

Blue Ash, Ohio, January 11, 2017 – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil and Blue Ash Chief of Police Paul Hartinger release the identity of a suspect in the shooting which occurred yesterday.

The Sheriff's Office Criminal Investigation Section is assisting the Blue Ash Police Department with a shooting incident at approximately 2:20 p.m. on January 10, 2017, at the Smashburger Restaurant in Blue Ash. The suspect in the shooting has been identified as Trey Phillip Gentry, a 19 year old male black, approximately 5'10" and 154 pounds. Mr. Gentry shot the victim several times before fleeing the scene. Gentry has been charged with Attempted Murder (2923.02 ORC) and is wanted by authorities.
