SHERIFF'S SGT. STRUCK HEAD ON

Green Township, Ohio, February 11, 2017 – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports one of his Sergeants received non-life threatening injuries after being struck head on in a vehicle accident earlier this morning.

At approximately 4:15 A.M. this morning a Sheriff's Office Sergeant was on patrol traveling northbound on North Bend Road in Green Township. As the Sergeant approached the intersection of Diehl Road a pickup truck traveling southbound crossed the center yellow lines and struck his cruiser head on. The impact caused a tremendous amount of debris and left the Sergeant entrapped in the cruiser. Green Township Fire and E.M.S. responded and extracted the Sergeant from his vehicle.

The driver of the pickup was transported to Mercy West Hospital and received treatment for non-life threatening injuries. The Sergeant was transported to University Hospital also sustaining non-life threatening injuries and is awaiting surgery for a broken leg.

At this time investigators do not believe the crash was alcohol and/or drug related. This crash remains under investigation by the Hamilton County Sheriff's Traffic Safety Unit.
