AGGRAVATED ROBBERY

Columbia Township, March 2, 2017 – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports an Aggravated Robbery that occurred on March 2, 2017 at 1:45 p.m., at the U. S. Bank located at 7435 Wooster Pike in Columbia Township.

A male suspect entered the bank, passed a threatening note to the teller demanding money. The teller provided the suspect with an unknown amount of US Currency and he fled on foot west on Wooster Pike.

The Criminal Investigation Section and Enforcement deputies of the Hamilton County Sheriff's Office responded and began an investigation. A short time later, detectives located and arrested the suspect at his residence. The suspect confessed and all monies were recovered.

Arrested was Steven J Manglona Jr., 7836 Hosbrook Road, Sycamore Township for Aggravated Robbery, a Felony of the 1st degree. Manglona was transported to the Hamilton County Justice Center.
