VEHICLE PURSUIT IN LINCOLN HEIGHTS

Village of Lincoln Heights, March 9, 2017 – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports a vehicle pursuit which began on I-75 at the 13.8 mile marker at 1:51 A.M. A Sheriff's Unit attempted to stop a 2017 Hyundai Santa Fe, grey in color, for a marked lanes violation. The vehicle stopped on the left shoulder, for a brief moment, and then continued northbound on I-75. The vehicle exited onto Union Centre Boulevard and continued onto Cincinnati Dayton Road. The pursuit ended in the 6600 block of Dimmick Road in West Chester Ohio. The two occupants fled on foot from the vehicle and a canine track was conducted by the West Chester Police Department resulting in the apprehension of the passenger of the vehicle. The driver remains at large.

The driver is described as a male, black, approximately 5'9", thin build, in his late teens to early twenties. The suspect was wearing a dark colored sweat shirt and reddish colored pants.

The passenger, located by the West Chester Canine, is identified as Trevon Adams, age 20, of Cincinnati, Ohio. He is being charged with Obstructing Official Business and Drug Possession.
