EAGLE CAPTURED BY SHERIFF'S FUGITIVE UNIT

Hamilton County, Ohio, April 24, 2017 – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports the arrest of James Eagle on outstanding warrants.

James Eagle was facing mostly traffic related misdemeanor charges when he decided to call authorities impersonating a judge and then a detective. Neither scheme was successful, except in adding three additional serious felony warrants for Aiding Escape or Resistance to Authority, Forgery, and Impersonation of a Peace officer. Mr. Eagle was apprehended by our Deputies in our Fugitive Warrants Unit / Marshals Southern Ohio Fugitive Apprehension Strike Force without incident at a residence in Dearborn County, Indiana. Eagle is being extradited and transported to the Hamilton County Justice Center to face all charges.
