Pursuit of Aggravated Robbery Suspect

Green Township, April 26, 2017 – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil and Green Township Chief James Vetter, Green Township Police Department, report a pursuit involving an aggravated robbery suspect from the City of Cincinnati.

At approximately 4:59p.m., officers in Green Township were advised through an All County Broadcast that a male black subject had just taken a vehicle described as a white SUV at gun point in the parking lot of the Home Depot, located at 6300 Glenway Ave Cincinnati, Ohio 45211.

Hamilton County Deputy Steven Junker observed the vehicle described in the offense exiting the parking lot. Deputy Junker attempted to initiate a traffic stop; however the vehicle refused to stop continuing southbound on Glenway Avenue. During the pursuit, the fleeing vehicle traveled at high speeds and drove erratically through heavy traffic. At the intersection of Queen City and Boudinot Avnue, the vehicle struck a black Kia stopped at a traffic signal. The vehicle then continued through a red traffic signal striking a City Public Works truck causing the vehicle to become disabled. Both Hamilton County Deputy Junker and Cincinnati Police Officer Sterbling took the suspect into custody.

The Hamilton County Sheriff's Office charged the male juvenile with Felony Fleeing and Eluding. The City of Cincinnati Police Department will be filing more charges.

The driver of the Kia reported no injuries. The driver and passenger of the City Public Work truck were transported to Mercy West Hospital for examinations.

The incident remains under investigation by the Hamilton County Sheriff / Green Township Police Investigative Unit.
