PERSON WANTED

Cincinnati, Ohio, June 15, 2017 – Sheriff Jim Neil reports the escape of Megan Miller from the Hamilton County Courthouse located at 1000 Main St., Cincinnati, Ohio 45202. Miller is a female 26 years of age, described as 5 ft 4 inches tall and weighing approximately 130 pounds, with brown hair and blue eyes. At approximately 12:00 pm., the subject escaped custody from the Hamilton County Sheriff's Office Room # 260 located on the 2nd floor of the Hamilton County Courthouse. At the time Miller was wearing black pants, black and white striped shirt, black sandals, and a black jacket draped over her left wrist. Miller was last seen exiting the courthouse at approximately 12:02pm and heading in a west bound direction on East Court Street. Miller may have a pair of handcuffs attached to her left wrist. She was ordered to serve time at the Hamilton County Justice Center for Possession of Heroin.
