MURDER INVESTIGATION

Sycamore Township, Hamilton County, Ohio, June 21, 2017 – Sheriff Jim Neil reports that deputies responded to a report of two individuals shot in the 8200 block of Blue Ash Road at approximately 12:08 am. Upon arrival, deputies found two male individuals suffering from gunshot wounds. Sycamore Township EMS responded to the scene and transported both victims to the University of Cincinnati Medical Center for emergency treatment. The victims have been identified as follows:

Victim # 1: Jacob H. Baker, male age 21 of Blue Ash

Victim # 2: Jarid A. Carl, male age 22 of Sycamore Township

Mr. Baker did not survive his injuries and was pronounced deceased at University Hospital. Mr. Carl was treated for his gunshot wound and was released early this morning.

This murder has direct ties to an incident which occurred just minutes earlier on June 20, 2017 at 11:35 pm at Car Rock Café located at 7912 Blue Ash Road in the City of Deer Park. Deer Park Officers were dispatched for reports of multiple individuals fighting and the report of a shot fired during that incident. The Deer Park Police Department and the Hamilton County Sheriff's Office will work cooperatively on these related investigations.

Witnesses have indicated that the shooter in this murder is male white in his mid 20's with short hair. He discharged his weapon from the passenger compartment of a silver vehicle which was last seen southbound on Blue Ash Road.
