VEHICLE PURSUIT IN SYCAMORE TOWNSHIP

Sycamore Township, July 21, 2017 – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports a vehicle pursuit which began in the 8000 block of Reading Road at 1:22 a.m. A Sheriff's Unit attempted to stop a 2002 Buick Century, tan in color, for being stolen out of the City of Cincinnati. The vehicle continued northbound on Reading Road and eventually continued onto multiple streets until crashing into a utility pole at the intersection of Cambridge and Edith Avenues in Columbia Township. The male juvenile driver was taken into custody without incident, however suffered non-life threatening injuries sustained from being unrestrained inside the vehicle. The male juvenile was transported to Children's Hospital prior to being transported to Juvenile Detention.

Present in the vehicle during the pursuit were two male juvenile passengers who suffered non-life threatening injuries. Both were treated at the scene and released to their guardians.

The juvenile driver was charged with Fleeing and Eluding, Receiving Stolen Property (Motor Vehicle) and Driving without a license.
