VEHICLE PURSUIT IN COLUMBIA TOWNSHIP

Columbia Township, August 17, 2017 – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports a vehicle pursuit which began in the 5200 block of Ridge Road at 12:14 a.m. A Sheriff's Unit attempted to stop a 2016 Nissan hatchback, silver in color, for a moving violation. The vehicle pulled into a business parking lot in the 5200 block of Ridge Road and as the deputy approached, the vehicle fled southbound out of the parking lot onto Ridge Road. The vehicle continued until crashing into a building at the corner of Ash Street and Norwood Avenue, in the city of Norwood. The male driver fled the scene and a canine search of the area was unsuccessful in locating the driver.

No occupants of the building were injured.
