BANK ROBBERY

Sycamore Township, Hamilton County, Ohio, – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports on October 30, 2017 at 4:44 pm. Sheriff's deputies were dispatched to the report of a bank robbery at the Union Savings Bank, 7435 Kenwood Road in Sycamore Township.

Upon arrival, the suspect had already fled the scene. A Sheriff's K-9 conducted a track, which was unsuccessful. Investigation revealed that the subject passed a note to the teller indicating that he was robbing the bank and had a firearm. The suspect obtained a yet to be determined amount of U.S. currency in this offense. There were no injuries reported during this robbery.

Wanted for Aggravated Robbery is a male white, 25-35 years of age, approximately 5'8"-6' tall, thin build, brown hair, thin beard that runs the jaw line, wearing a black hooded sweatshirt, a black ball cap with sunglasses resting on the brim, and blue jeans. This subject was last seen heading south on Kenwood Road from the bank.

This suspect very closely matches the description of the person wanted for a bank robbery on October 25th in the City of Cincinnati.
