DOUBLE SHOOTING AT THE MCDONALD'S RESTAURANT IN ANDERSON TOWNSHIP

Anderson Township, December 13, 2017 – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports the attempted murder of two employees at the McDonald's restaurant located at 7671 Beechmont Avenue in Anderson Township.

At 10:50 pm, Zachary Allart, an employee at the McDonald's restaurant who was working there at the time, shot two co-workers: Denise Higgins and Jayla Frost. Denise Higgins is a McDonald's manager, and Jayla Frost is an employee and also Zachary Allart's ex-girlfriend. When uniformed deputies arrived, Zachary Allart had a gun to his head and was threatening to shoot himself. Deputies deescalated the situation and Allart surrendered the firearm. He was taken into custody without further incident.

Both victims were transported to University Hospital and are in critical condition. Zachary Allart was charged with two counts of Attempted Murder and has been transported to the Hamilton County Justice Center.
