AGGRAVATED ROBBERY AT THE DAYS INN COLUMBIA TOWNSHIP

Columbia Township, February 8, 2018 – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports an Aggravated Robbery at the Days Inn located at 5410 Ridge Avenue in Columbia Township.

At 0300 a.m., an employee at the Days Inn who was working as a night clerk, was behind the motel counter when a male black suspect walked into the office and demanded that the employee give him all the money. The suspect jumped over the counter and grabbed the money from the money drawer and then got into an unknown vehicle and fled the parking lot.

A Blue Ash Police Department officer and canine assisted Sheriff's deputies, but did not track the suspect due to him fleeing in a unknown vehicle.

The Hamilton County Sheriff's Criminal Investigative Unit responded. Evidence was collected and processed.
