AGGRAVATED ROBBERY - ARLINGTON HEIGHTS

Arlington Heights, May 4, 2018 – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports an Aggravated Robbery of a Domino's Pizza delivery driver at 310 Clark Street. At approximately 1:14pm a male 17 years old, brandishing a handgun approached the driver after she exited her vehicle to make a delivery. After taking the food the suspect fled on foot. No one was injured in the offense.

A short time later, the suspect was located and taken into custody by the Hamilton County Sheriff's Office. The juvenile suspect was charged with Aggravated Robbery and Carrying Concealed Weapons then transported to 2020.
