AGGRAVATED ROBBERY - CVS – VILLAGE OF SILVERTON

Village of Silverton, June 7, 2018 – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports an Aggravated Robbery that occurred at 6:51 P.M., CVS Pharmacy, 7314 Montgomery Road, Village of Silverton, Ohio.

A male black, early 20's, wearing a black Adidas jump suit, an emoji fishing hat with a wig attached, and sunglasses entered CVS and walked to the Pharmacy located in the rear of the store. The suspect then passed a handwritten note demanding scheduled narcotics of Oxycodone and threatened to harm anyone who used the phone. The suspect was exiting the store when a Deputy Sheriff confronted the suspect. The suspect was able to flee the store, however after a short foot pursuit was taken into custody.

The Hamilton County Sheriff's Office will be charging Matthew Monie III with multiple charges.
