### AGGRAVATED ROBBERY IN COLUMBIA TOWNSHIP

**Columbia Township, December 2, 2018** – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports an Aggravated Robbery which occurred at the Subway restaurant located at 7431 Wooster Pike, in Columbia Township, at 8:10p.m.

A former employee entered the restaurant demanding money from the cash register and when she was refused, she brandished a silver handgun. The victim fled to the rear of the store while the suspect removed an undetermined amount of U.S. currency from the register. The suspect fled on foot in an unknown direction. No one was injured during the offense.

The Hamilton County Sheriff's Officer filed a felony warrant for Aggravated Robbery on Lei Adre Dorsey, female black 18 years of age.
