SHOOTING IN GOLF MANOR

Village of Golf Manor, December 25, 2018 – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports a cooperative investigation with the Golf Manor Police Department and Chief Chris Campbell.

On December 25, 2018, Golf Manor Officers responded to 911 calls of shots fired in the 6400 block of Mayflower Ave. Upon investigating, officers found Joshua Griewe suffering from gunshot wounds in the front yard of 6435 Mayflower. Paramedics responded and transported Mr. Griewe to University Hospital for treatment. Mr. Griewe is currently listed in serious condition.

Investigation revealed the Mr. Griewe was shot outside of the residence of an acquaintance. The suspect(s) were the occupants of a four door vehicle which was last seen fleeing the area on Bremont Ave.

This shooting was not a random act of violence and it is apparent that Mr. Griewe was the intended target of this felonious assault.
