DRIVER ARRESTED AT NAGEL MIDDLE SCHOOL

Anderson Township, February 19, 2019 – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports the arrest of a suspected impaired driver who struck two vehicles in the lot of Nagel Middle School located at 1500 Nagel Road in Anderson Township on Tuesday, February 19, 2019 at 8:17 a.m.

Ellen Craven, female, age 50 of Cincinnati, Ohio was operating a 2015 Mazda 3 in the lot of 1500 Nagel Rd. Ms. Craven was seen by witnesses driving off the roadway and over curbs. Ms. Craven was making a right turn inside the lot when she traveled into oncoming traffic and struck another vehicle. Ms. Craven continued into the student drop off lane where her vehicle struck a second vehicle. After dropping off her child, Ms. Craven left the scene and her vehicle became disabled after driving off the roadway.

Ms. Craven was arrested for OVI and Child Endangerment. Ms. Craven was transported to the Hamilton County Justice Center.

All parties involved were utilizing their safety restraints and no reported injuries.

Drugs/medication are believed to be a factor in the crash but speed is not a factor in this crash. The crash remains under investigation by the Hamilton County Sheriff's Traffic Safety Unit.
