Attempted Assault of Deputy Sheriff at the Hamilton County Court House

Cincinnati Ohio, February 25, 2019 – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports the arrest of Carlos Hoskins M/B DOB 01/07/1992. Investigation began when Mr. Hoskins entered the Hamilton County Sheriff's Court Services, Room 260, Hamilton County Court House, to be recited on an open warrant. Computer check by deputies revealed the defendant was wanted on a Felony warrant for Carrying a Conceal Weapon. Deputies attempted to escort Mr. Hoskins to the rear of the office at which time Mr. Hoskins became disorderly. While placing him in handcuffs, he resisted arrest and swung at the arresting officer. After a short scuffle with deputies, Mr. Hopkins was placed in custody. As a result of the investigation, Mr. Hopkins was charged with Assault of a Police Officer, Felony of the Fourth Degree, Resisting Arrest, Misdemeanor of the First Degree, Disorderly Conduct, Minor Misdemeanor, and other Felony warrants. The arresting officer was not injured as a result of the incident. Mr. Hopkins was transported to the Hamilton County Justice Center.
