US Bank Robbery

Sycamore Township, February 22, 2019 – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports the Aggravated Robbery of US Bank located at 10851 Montgomery Road on February 22, 2019 at approximately 2:52 pm.

Deputies were dispatched for a hold up alarm which was upgraded to the report of an Aggravated Robbery that had just occurred.

The suspect was described as: male black, 40-50 years of age, wearing a gray suit with black dress shoes, glasses, black gloves and carrying a black semi auto handgun.

Investigation revealed that the suspect entered the bank, displayed a handgun and jumped up on the teller counter. The suspect demanded cash from the victim teller while holding her at gunpoint. The suspect fled the bank using the north doors with a yet to be determined amount of US Currency. A K-9 tracked from the scene which ended a short distance later, in the parking lot of a nearby business. There were a total of five employees and one customer in the bank at the time of the robbery, no one was injured in this offense.
