Arson Arrest Anderson Township

Anderson Township, May 5, 2019 – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports the arrest of Megan Miller, 26, of Anderson Township for Arson.

On May 5, 2019, at 12:30 AM, Hamilton County Sheriff's Deputies were dispatched to the 2000 Block of Endo Valley Drive for a residential structure fire. Upon their arrival, the deputies observed an active fire through the front doors and windows of the residence on the main floor. The house was unoccupied at the time of the fire. After a short investigation it was learned that the fire was intentionally set by Megan Miller who resides in the home. Miller was located and taken to the Hamilton County Justice Center after being treated for minor injuries at University of Cincinnati Hospital. Miller was charged with a single count of Arson, a felony of the fourth degree.

The investigation is being jointly handled by the Hamilton County Sheriff's Office Criminal Investigation Section and Anderson Township Fire Investigators.
