Drug Trafficking-Cleves Ohio

Village of Cleves, May 10, 2019 – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports the arrest of Brian Carraway, M/B 27yoa, after a joint investigation conducted by the Hamilton County Sheriff's Regional Narcotics Unit, Green Township Police and Homeland Security Investigations which resulted in the recovery of several weapons and illegal narcotics. He was arrested at 505 Laurelwood Drive Cleves Ohio 45002. The investigation resulted in the recovery of:

27 pounds of Marijuana

108 THC infused cigars,

12.7 pounds of THC infused gummy worms, fruit rings and sour watermelon slices (Candy)

1,333 THC vape cartridges (1.1 gram),

39 ounces of concentrated THC hash wax,

Four high powered rifles,

One Glock pistol,

Two shotguns,

\$15,642.00 U.S. Currency.

Brian Carraway has been charged with two counts of Drug Trafficking (F2 and F3) and two counts of Drug Possession (F2 and F3).
