SINGLE VEHICLE INJURY CRASH IN FOREST PARK

City of Forest Park, May 28th, 2019 – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil and Chief William Arns, Forest Park Police, report a single vehicle crash that occurred on I.R. 275 near the 38.5 mile marker in Forest Park on Tuesday, May 28, 2019 at 9:52am.

A 2005 Mitsubishi Lancer, being operated by Nicole Ann Hudson, female, age 31, of Fairfield, Ohio was traveling eastbound on I.R. 275 near the 38.5 mile marker. Ms. Hudson lost control of her vehicle as she changed from the center lane to the right lane. Ms. Hudson's vehicle ran off the right side of the road, rolled over and traveled up an embankment before coming to rest in a wooded area.

Ms. Hudson was transported to University Hospital by the Forest Park Fire Department for treatment of non-life threatening injuries.

Ms. Hudson's child, female, age 4, was transported to Children's Hospital by the Forest Park Fire Department where she was treated and released.

Ms. Hudson was utilizing her safety restraint at the time of the crash and her daughter was properly restrained in a car seat.

Alcohol and speed were factors in the crash.

Ms. Hudson will be charged with Failure to Maintain Reasonable Control, a minor misdemeanor, Operating a Vehicle While Intoxicated and Child Endangerment, both misdemeanors of the first degree.
