SINGLE VEHICLE CRASH WITH ENTRAPMENT IN SILVERTON

Village of Silverton, May 30th, 2019 – Hamilton County Sheriff Jim Neil reports a single vehicle crash that occurred on Stewart Road in the Village of Silverton on May 30th, 2019 at 12:39 p.m.

A 2011 Subaru operated by Matthew Combs, male, age 25, of Cincinnati, Ohio was traveling southbound in the 6200 block of Stewart Road. As he traveled through a right curve Mr. Combs lost control of his vehicle causing it to travel off the right side of the road and strike an unoccupied parked vehicle. Mr. Combs' vehicle continued out of control until it struck a utility pole in front of 6251 Stewart Road.

Mr. Combs was mechanically extricated from his vehicle by the Deer Park/Silverton and Sycamore Township Fire Departments. He was trapped for approximately 40 minutes. He was then transported to University Hospital by the Deer Park/Silverton Fire Department where he is in critical condition.

Mr. Combs was wearing a seatbelt at the time of the crash. Alcohol and speed are believed to be factors in the crash.

The crash remains under investigation by the Sheriff's Traffic Safety Unit.
